# Single status statutory declaration

You will need to book an appointment with a solicitor, a Commissioner for oath officer or a notary officer to apply for this declaration. The declaration must be dated within 3 months of your marriage date. Below is an example of what must be included:

All documents excluding your passports must be legalised with an apostille stamp by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office. There are several ways of obtaining this stamp by searching online. This will include https://www.gov.uk/get-document-legalised.
